

Using 3 Matkas to make a composter

To work like a Kambha



Daily Dump
COMPOST AT HOME

What you need:

3 Matkas Medium sized

1 Lid

Buy 3 Medium size Matkas and lid from the local pottery shop - usually on the roadside.

1 Support for the bottom

Be creative, use a small flat pot or any other thing that will do the job

1 Drilling Machine

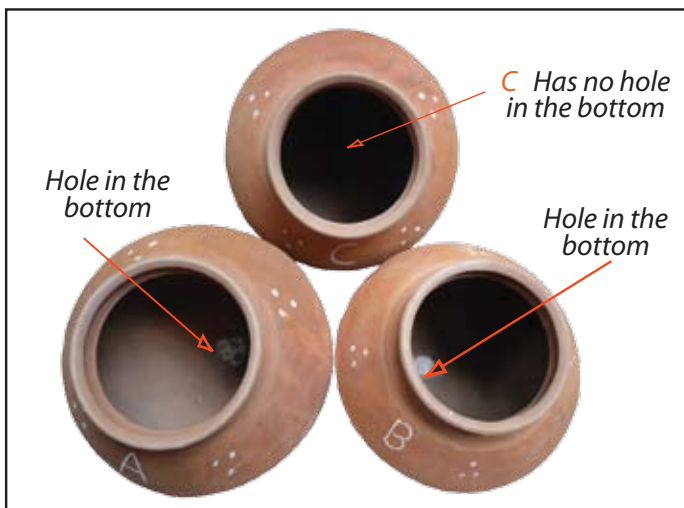
With a masonry drill bit to make 6mm to 8 mm hole

1 Chalk piece



1 Extension Box
If necessary

How to make



1 Mark the holes on the pots. You can do a set of three on the 4 cardinal directions or even one in the 4 cardinal directions. Matka A and B will also have a hole drilled at the bottom of the pot

2 Begin drilling. Be careful, you will need help. Get two other people to hold the pots and also provide some cushion support beneath to absorb the vibrations. Always put off the switch when you adjust the drill bit or in between drilling.



3 Assemble the three matkas as shown with C at the bottom. Congratulations, you have made a composter! You can keep waste out of the street. Keep it out of the rain. And support it against a wall or brace. It is unstable and can topple. To use this, follow all the instructions of the 3 tiered composter on our website.
